Public Transportation

Bus

The closest [NJ TRANSIT bus](#) stop to the Rutgers Camden Campus Center is the Walter Rand Transportation Center at Broadway and Mickle Blvd., a 10-15 minute walk from the Campus Center. Here are bus lines that travel to downtown with multiple stops in Camden. Click on the bus route number to get full schedule and stops:

[#450](#) – Camden – Audubon – Cherry Hill Mall. Camden stops include: Morgan Blvd. at Broadway, Broadway at Kaighn Ave., and Walter Rand Transportation Center.

[#451](#) – Camden – Voorhees Town Center. Camden stops include Walter Rand Transportation Center, Haddon Ave at Vesper Blvd.

[#452](#) – Camden (Cramer Hill) – 36th Street Station (Pennsauken). Camden stops include: Front Street at State Street, Adventure Aquarium, Walter Rand Transportation Center, Broadway at Kaighn Ave., Park Blvd. at Baird Blvd (Camden High School), 27th Street at Westfield Ave., KROC Center.

[#453](#) – Ferry Avenue PATCO – Camden. Camden stops include Federal St. at Delaware Ave, Walter Rand Transportation Center, Broadway at Kaighn Ave., Ferry Ave. PATCO.

Rail

River Line



The [NJ TRANSIT River Line](#) light-rail system has a southbound stop (Cooper Street/Rutgers Station) on campus at Third and Cooper Streets. PATCO Speedline



[PATCO Speedline](#) offers easy train access from southern New Jersey and Philadelphia. The City Hall station at Fifth and Market Streets, one block from campus, is the nearest Rutgers–Camden stop.

From City Hall station, walk north toward Cooper Street. Note: PATCO operate with altered schedules as it completes track work on the Benjamin Franklin Bridge. See [PATCO schedules](#).

Driving Directions

On a GPS or navigation app, entering "326 Penn St., Camden, New Jersey" will take you to the campus entry at Third and Cooper Streets. We encourage drivers to use a GPS or navigation app in conjunction with the directions below.

New Jersey Turnpike (North or South)

- Turn off at Exit 4. After toll booths proceed on Route 73 North approximately one mile to Route 38 West.
- Route 38 will merge with Route 30.
- Proceed on Route 30 West for approximately one mile where the road forks.
- Take the right fork marked "Local Traffic Only, Last Exit Before Toll."
- Continue straight ahead to Seventh Street and turn left.
- At the foot of the Seventh Street Bridge, turn right onto Cooper Street.
- The campus entry at Third and Cooper Streets will be several blocks ahead on the right.

Route 295

Southbound - Coming from the north

- Turn off at Route 38 West exit at Moorestown.
- Route 38 will merge with Route 30.
- Proceed on Route 30 West for approximately one mile where the road forks.
- Take the right fork marked "Local Traffic Only, Last Exit Before Toll."
- Continue straight ahead to Seventh Street and turn left.

- At the foot of the Seventh Street Bridge, turn right onto Cooper Street.
- The campus entry at Third and Cooper Streets will be several blocks ahead on the right.

Northbound - Coming from the south

- Turn off at exit for North-South Freeway (Route 42).
- Follow signs to Camden, exiting at Route 676.
- Proceed along Route 676 to Exit 5B marked “Last Exit Before Toll - Benjamin Franklin Bridge.”
- Turn left onto Linden Street at the first stop light. Continue one block to Seventh Street and turn left again.
- At the foot of the Seventh Street Bridge, turn right onto Cooper Street.
- The campus entry at Third and Cooper Streets will be several blocks ahead on the right.

Atlantic City Expressway

- Pick-up the North-South Freeway (Route 42).
- Follow signs to Camden, exiting at Route 676.
- Proceed along Route 676 to Exit 5B marked “Last Exit Before Toll - Benjamin Franklin Bridge.”
- Turn left onto Linden Street at the first stop light. Continue one block to Seventh Street and turn left again.
- At the foot of the Seventh Street Bridge, turn right onto Cooper Street.
- The campus entry at Third and Cooper Streets will be several blocks ahead on the right.

Admiral Wilson Boulevard (Route 30 West)

- Proceed approximately one mile from the Airport Circle where the road forks.
- Take the right fork marked “Local Traffic Only, Last Exit Before Toll.”
- Continue straight ahead to Seventh Street and turn left.
- At the foot of the Seventh Street Bridge, turn right onto Cooper Street.
- The campus entry at Third and Cooper Streets will be several blocks ahead on the right.

Philadelphia

Benjamin Franklin Bridge via route 676

- Entering New Jersey from Route 676, stay to the right.
- Follow signage for “Sixth Street/Broadway” and take that exit.
- On the exit ramp, bear right toward Sixth Street and stop sign.
- Once through stop sign at the end of the exit, go one block to Cooper Street and make a right.
- The campus entry at Third and Cooper Streets will be several blocks ahead on the right.

Walt Whitman Bridge via route 76

- Entering New Jersey from Route 76, take the “Camden/Gloucester City” exit.
- Proceed in the left lane about 1,000 feet to the Camden Exit.
- Turn left and continue on Route 676 to Exit 5B marked “Last Exit Before Toll - Benjamin Franklin Bridge.”
- Turn left onto Linden Street at the first stop light.
- Continue one block to Seventh Street and turn left again.
- At the foot of the Seventh Street Bridge, turn right onto Cooper Street.
- The campus entry at Third and Cooper Streets will be several blocks ahead on the right.

Parking Maps

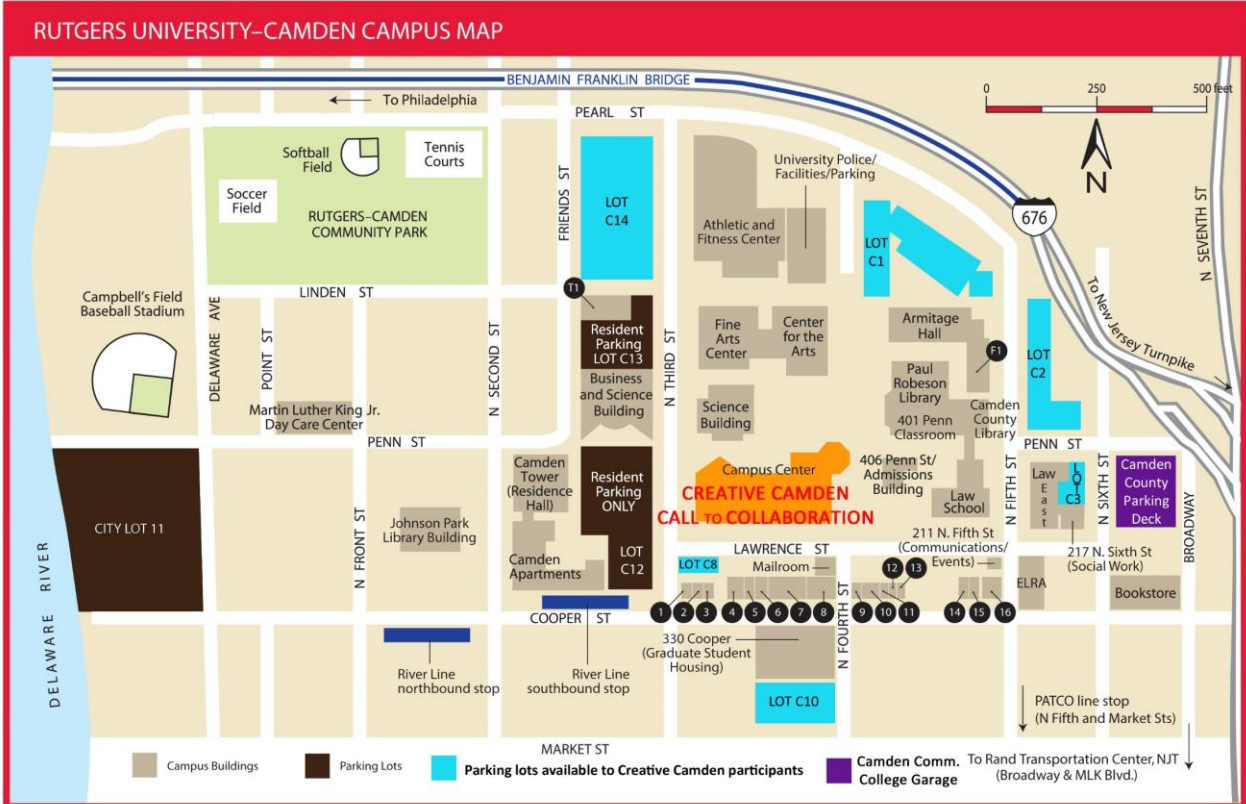
Parking:

Option #1: Rutgers University-Camden has graciously opened most of its lots to Call to Collaboration participants and has waived ticketing. Those lots are indicated in bright blue on the map below. **PLEASE NOTE: Lots C13 and C12 are NOT available for parking and you will be ticketed if you park there. Lot C14 is closest to the Campus Center and will fill quickly.** Please be sure to leave enough time to park and walk to the Campus Center.

Option # 2: The Camden Community College garage, indicated in purple on the map below. The Camden Community College garage is open to the public. Normal ticketing fees apply.

Option #3: Metered on-street parking is available on Third Street, portions of Pearl Street, and surrounding streets.
